This area was a swamp twenty years ago and now is the temporary housing for people who come to Mexico City from the countryside looking for work. There are no government services in this area and the dirt streets are heavily littered.

Minerva Cortez, former Pastor of Tlalamac, has accepted the challenge of building this church program.

The need is great for proper childcare.

Teams from Sardis, MS, Tupelo, MS and Vicksburg, MS have helped to build the sanctuary, which is nearing completion.

Construction is beginning on the parsonage and classrooms located within the church compound.

Teams providing medical service, food, clothing and bible school programs are welcomed.
