Templo “La Santísima Trinidad”

Repair and restore the historic church.

Located in the central district of the capital of Guanajuato state, the “La Santísima Trinidad” church is uniquely positioned for outreach to a major metropolitan area. At present the congregation is small, partly due to inadequate facilities. The members have had to meet in borrowed facilities because of safety concerns for their building.

They have had to vacate their rented facility and are, of necessity, back in the old building.

The church in Guanajuato is in a historic district. Repair and reconstruction is governed by special regulations regarding historic structures. Permits have been issued for the work.



There are several phases of work planned. The first is to repair the overhang in the central patio. Portions of the old material have crumbled and fallen.

A second major concern is the high humidity which causes the walls to sweat and deteriorate.

The tiny parsonage portion of the building is cool and damp and unhealthy for the pastor and family. Repair of the walls and solving the humidity problem are critical.

The need is urgent. This is the only Methodist church in a major city. The presence of VIM teams can be a powerful witness to the local community, and provide hope and encouragement to a small congregation.



The anticipated restoration cost is \$70,000. However, this does not take into consideration the use of volunteers, which can reduce the cost significantly.
